There will be an additional charge if your child requires a higher level of care if they have special food requirements (add **\$50.00** for special food handling)

- All children under 18 must wear an approved riding helmet.
- Weight limit of 180 pounds

Technology: No cell phones or techno game items

Cancellation Policy: No refunds. If the cancellation is accompanied by a doctor's note the camp can be transferred to another date within a year.

- We reserve the right to dismiss any camper that is not compatible with the camp programs. You will be required to come and get them. There will be NO refunds
